NOTES FROM PARKS VIC ABOUT DEVILBEND

We recently received information about Devilbend Natural Features Reserve Hydrology Project— which in summary calls for our response to a proposal to divert water from the catch drains to "top up" the reservoirs during the winter flow period. The proposal is considered essential to maintain sustainable water levels and protect the high habitat values of the reservoirs. Completed flows studies have nominated two locations for construction of these diversions which will enable the proposed levels to be maintained. A significant statement in the report notes that based on rainfall, catchment conditions and water storage levels over the past three years, diversions would not have been required!

Terry was the most successful fisherman of the group with a bag of browns and rainbows.




